




What is the Enterprise Operating Framework?

- An integrated, executable representation of NGA's strategy to accomplish its objectives
- A defined set of critical operating capabilities
- The next step towards NGA's long-term goal
- Not inclusive of all activities within all Key Components (KCs)
- Provides NGA with *laser-like* planning and execution capability
 - Focus: Everyone targeted to same objective
 - Coherence: Everyone working in unison to coordinate and link their efforts to achieve that objective

Enterprise Operating Framework

- 1) **Analytical Depth**
Broaden analytical depth to address increasingly more complex mission demands
- 2) **Source Management**
Proactively and systematically acquire access to all pertinent sources and source data and infuse into the analytical process to best meet current and future intelligence needs
- 3) **Integrated Information Environment**
Create, populate and provide access to one logical physical or virtual) repository for all NGA Geospatial Intelligence holdings (data, information and knowledge)
- 4) **Rapid Innovation**
Enable an enterprise wide capability that measurably improves the delivery speed and customer value of technology, business process, and tradecraft innovations deployed into operations
- 5) **NGA Corporate Customer Management**
To gather and integrate customer intelligence to be used in enterprise decision-making activities
- 6) **Customer Self-Service Web Portal**
One-stop access to all NGA: Provide integrated access to NGA's information services
- 7) **Fail Safe Business Continuity Assurance**
Provide continuous operations of critical mission functionality through disruptions and disasters
- 8) **Leadership and Governance**
Corporate Strategy, Governing Principles, Decision Support, Enterprise Architecture, and Performance Metrics
