Ms. Kimberly Fite serves as the Director of the Source Operations and Management Directorate, National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA), having previously served as its Deputy Director from November 2014 to October 2017. In her current capacity as Source Director, Ms. Fite is responsible for creating, collecting, brokering, and delivering authoritative GEOINT content and services to support national security priorities.

From October 2013 to October 2014, Ms. Fite served as NGA's Lead for Leader Development where she was a catalyst for shifting the agency's culture in line with the agency strategy.

Beginning in 2011 through September 2013, Ms. Fite served as the Director of the Office of Special Programs, Analysis and Production Directorate, responsible for all aspects of special GEOINT activities in support of Intelligence Community and Department of Defense mission partners, including program planning and execution in areas of acquisition, analysis and production, collection management, security, dissemination, and rapid insertion of innovative technologies.

Ms. Fite served as the Director of the Analysis directorate's Office of Asia Pacific from May 2009 to July 2011, responsible for GEOINT analysis on deployed strategic, theater forces and political instability in the Asia Pacific region.

From April 2006 to May 2009, Ms. Fite served as the Deputy Director, of NGA's Office of Counterproliferation within the Analysis directorate, responsible for geospatial intelligence against weapons of mass destruction, advanced weapons systems technology, and proliferation-related issues. She was serving in this capacity when she was selected for the Defense Intelligence Senior Executive Service in September 2007.

Prior positions have included Director of the Workforce Development and Tradecraft Office and Chief of the Program Division, Financial Management Directorate.

Ms. Fite began her federal career in 1987, spending several years as an imagery analyst with the National Photographic Interpretation Center and the Defense Intelligence Agency. She also held positions at the Central Imagery Office, the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Command, Control, Communications and Intelligence, and the Central Imagery Tasking Organization.

Ms. Fite received undergraduate degrees in geology and liberal arts from Virginia Tech.
