



TRIM-A-TREE WITH IMAGERY

We recommend printing out this craft on heavier cardstock. Cut out the trees out along their outline. Next, glue or tape the red and purple tree together with the imagery facing out. Do the same for the green and white trees. Make sure the white dotted lines match up on both pairs. Cut along the center dotted lines as indicated. Slot the two trees together to form a 3D-ornament. Feel free to decorate the tree with markers, glitter or stickers. To hang it from your tree, punch a hole for the hanging loop and thread a length of twine through, tying the ends in a knot. Use a paperclip to make a hook.
