1.0 INTRODUCTION

This Statement of Work (SOW) addresses support to the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA). The Security and Installations Directorate, Insider Threat Program (SI/ITP) has a requirement for training / technical exchange discussions (TED) on the Raytheon 'InnerView' tool.

2.0 GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Contractor shall be required to provide the following services at the Raytheon facility in Springfield, Virginia:

- a. Two (2) sessions of the 'InnerView Operation Overview' for management, four hours per session
- b. Two (2) sessions of a customized 'Core InnerView Operation', twelve hours per session
- c. Each session is limited to ten (10) personnel, maximum.

The 'InnerView Operation Overview' for management should include the following topics/modules:

- System Architecture
- Detection Capabilities
- Overview of Enterprise Application Suite (EAS)
- Q&A

The Contractor shall provide copies of all training materials for each participant.
